BOYS BASKETBALL CAMP

Camp Director: Matt St. Croix



Matt St. Croix is the Head Coach of the Men's Basketball Program at MVCC. Under his direction, the Hawks have consistently qualified for the NJCAA's Region III Tournament while compiling winning records. Previously, St. Croix was the head coach at Jefferson Community College. He was also an assistant coach at St. John Fisher College for two seasons. During those seasons the Cardinals went 55-7 and made it to the NCAA sweet sixteen twice. As a JV head coach, St. Croix led Fisher to an undefeated record, helping to prepare many of Fisher's current varsity players.

Prior to the start of his coaching career, St. Croix enjoyed a successful 4-year playing career at St. John Fisher College. He helped lead the Cardinals to three NCAA tournaments and Empire 8 championships. During his senior season he was the starting point guard on a team that finished 21-4 and won the Empire 8 title.

Coach St. Croix brings a wealth of knowledge and enthusiasm to the MVCC basketball camp having been an instructor at camps for the past nine years. Some notable camps that St. Croix has been part of are Eastern Invitational, Bob Hurley, Five-Star, Pocono, Seton Hall, St John Fisher, LeMoyne and Potsdam.

Co-director Jason Carpenter

Coach Carpenter just finished his second season as assistant coach with the Hawks. He was a former Academic All-American at Mohawk Valley Community College and brings a wealth of knowledge and enthusiasm to the camp. Previous to MVCC, he was an assistant at Oneonta State for three years. He also has coached numerous Division 1 and professional players in his experience as an assistant coach with the Empire State games Central Team. He has been involved in the MVCC basketball camp in the past and will be again this year.
