

2009-2010 Verification Worksheet

Federal Student Aid Programs

Your application was selected for review in a process called "verification." In this process, your school will be comparing information from your application with signed copies of your 2008 federal tax forms (and your spouse's if you are married, or parents' if you are considered dependent for federal aid purposes). Try to complete verification as soon as possible, so that your financial aid won't be delayed. You must provide the required documents before the end of the semester or before you drop below half-time status, whichever comes first. **Your financial aid will not be processed until verification requirements are complete.** Your school must review the requested information, under the financial aid program rules (CFR Title 34, Part 668).

What you should do:

1. Collect your (and your spouse's or parents') financial documents (signed income tax form, W-2, etc.).
2. Talk to your financial aid administrator if you have questions about completing this worksheet.
3. **Be sure to sign the worksheet** - you (and your spouse or parents).
4. Take the completed worksheet, tax forms, and any other documents to your financial aid administrator.
5. Your financial aid administrator will compare information on these documents and make corrections if necessary.

Tax Forms and Income Information

All tax filers must submit a signed copy of all 2008 Federal Income Tax returns (includes the 2008 IRS Form 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ, Telefile Tax Record, a tax return from Puerto Rico or a foreign income tax return) .

If you did not keep a copy of your tax return, you must request a federal tax transcript from the Internal Revenue Service by calling 1-800-829-1040.

Check the box for those people who did not and were not required to file a 2008 Federal Income Tax Return. Report all income earned from work in 2008 below and submit W-2 forms or other earning statements with this form.
