

**CHECK LIST only FOR STUDENTS ENTERING  
NURSING 101, new LPN's or transfer students testing into  
NU102, NU103, NU201, NU202:**

1. **American Heart Association Healthcare Provider CPR** that will carry you through 2 years of nursing courses
2. **Physical exam** done after Spring semester This will carry you thru 2 years of Nursing courses
3. **Current Mantoux** (Needs to be repeated before entering Nursing 201.)

Reading will state either negative; a zero (which means negative) or a zero with a line drawn through it which means negative. If the Mantoux states positive, a chest x-ray is required to rule out tuberculosis. A copy of the chest x-ray needs to be on file. ) This x-ray is good for two years.

4. **Rubella Titer:**  
Must be positive and be in numerical form. We also need the lab sheet stating positive results.
5. **Varicella (Chicken Pox):**  
Need a history of disease.  
If the student is unsure as to the history of having the disease (chicken pox), then a titer for varicella with a positive reading must be done and the lab slip needs to be on file.

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
